- 15 For some are already turned aside after Satan.
- 16 If any man or woman that believeth have widows, let them relieve them, and let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed.
- 17 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.

Verse 16:

16 If any man or woman that believeth have widows, vs. 3-5

let them **relieve** them, *FM: Lev.25:35, Is.1:17* and let not the church be **charged**; *1 Th.2:9* that it may **relieve** them that are **widows indeed**. v.3

Verses 17 & 18:

- 17 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, *Rom.2:10*, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine. *1 Cor.3:8, 1Th. 5:12*
- 18 For the scripture saith, *Deut. 25:4, 1 Cor.9:14*Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn.

The labourer is worthy of his **reward**. *Lu. 10:7*
