- 6 But godliness with contentment is great gain.
- 7 For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.
- 8 And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.
- 9 But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.
- 10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

- 7 For we **brought nothing** into this world, *Job.1:21*, and it is certain we can **carry** nothing out. *Ps.49:7*, *Ec.5:15*
- 8 And having **food and raiment** (1 Ti. 2:9,Gen.28:20) let us be therewith **content**. Phil.4:11, Heb. 13:5

9 But they that **will be rich** *Pr.15:27, Pr.28:20, Jas. 5:1* fall into temptation and a **snare**, *1 Tim. 3:7* and into **many** foolish and hurtful **lusts**, *FM: Mk. 4:19*
