2 Timothy Lesson 1 Introduction

A. Background of Timothy:

- 1. First encounter with Paul in Derbe- Acts16. His father was a Gentile, his mother a Jewess.
- 2. He worked with Paul in Berea (Ac. 17:14), Corinth (Ac.18:5), Macedonia (Ac.19:22), Asia (20:4).
- 3. He was sent by Paul to: Thessalonica (1 Th. 3:2-6), Corinth (1 Cor. 4:17), Ephesus (1 Tim.1:3) and Philippi (Phi.2:19).
- 4. He was included in the salutations by Paul in the letters to the Philippians, Colossians, Thessalonians and Philemon.
- 5. He was imprisoned at some time (Heb. 13:23).
- 6. He was often ill (1 Tim. 5:23).
- 7. Paul wrote two letters to him.

- B. Background of the Epistle:
 - 1. Written by Paul during his second imprisonment (1:8) probably late 67-early 68AD
 - 2. The letter itself contains 4 chapters, 83 verses comprised of 1,665 words.
 - 3. Key words:

Remembrance (4x), Ashamed (4x), Suffer (4x), Appearing (3x)

4. Key phrases: That Day, The Faith, Rightly Dividing

Key verse: 2. Tim. 2:15

- 5. Unique Words: Canker 2:9, Evangelist, Heady 3:4, Highminded, Immortality, Incontinent 3:3, Parchments 4:13, Proof, Shun 2:16, Trucebreakers 3:3, Ungodliness
- 6. Parallel chapter is Isaiah = 55
