24 And the servant of the Lord must not strive;
but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach,
patient,

25 In meekness instructing those that oppose
themselves; if God peradventure will give them
repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;

26 And that they may recover themselves out
of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive
by him at his will.

Verse 24:

24 And the servant of the Lord must **not strive**;

but be **gentle** unto all men, *1 Thess. 2:7, Tit.3:2*

apt to teach, *1 Tim.3:2*

patient, *1 Th.5:14*

Verse 25:

25 In **meekness** (Gal.6:1)

instructing those that **oppose themselves**; *Ac. 18:6,2*
Th.2:4

if God **peradventure** (*FM.Gen.18:24 = perhaps, it may be*)
will give them repentance to the **acknowledging of**
the truth; *Ti.1:1*

Verse 26:

26 And that they may recover themselves out of the **snare of the devil**, *1 Tim.3:7*

who are **taken captive** by him at his will.
