[Titus 1:1-4 Lesson 2]

1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;

2 In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

3 But hath in due times manifested his word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the commandment of God our Saviour;

4 To Titus, mine own son after the common faith:
Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.

Verse 1:

1 Paul, a **servant** of God, *Rom.1:1a, 1 Cor.9:19*
and an **apostle** of Jesus Christ, *Rom.1:1b, 1 Tim.1:1*
according to the faith of God's elect, *Rom.8:33*
and the **acknowledging** of the truth (*2 Tim.2:25, Phi.6*)
which is after godliness; *1 Tim.6:3*

[Titus 1:1-4 Lesson 2]

Verse 2:

2 In hope of **eternal life**, *Rom.5:21, 6:23, Ti.3:7*

which God, that **cannot lie**, *Num.23:19, 2 Tim.2:13*

promised **before** the world began; *Rom.16:25-26*

[Titus 1:1-4 Lesson 2]

Verse 3:

3 But hath in **due times** (*Rom.5:6, 1 Cor.15:8*)

manifested his word through **preaching**, *Ac.15:35, 1
Cor.18, 2 Tim.4:17*

which is **committed** unto me according to the
commandment of God our Saviour;

Verse 4:

4 To Titus, *FM: 2 Cor.2:13, 7:13-15,8:6,16,23, Gal.2:3,*
mine **own son** (*1 Tim.1:2*) *Son, Brother, Partner, Fellow*
helper, Comforter, Finisher, He Cares, Remembers, has inward
affection for believers,

after the **common faith**: *Rom.1:12*

Grace, mercy, and peace, *see 1 & 2 Tim. Salutations*
from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our
Saviour.
