15 Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.

16 They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

Verse 15:

15 Unto the **pure** all things are **pure**: *FM: Ex.25:11*
but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is
nothing **pure**; *Ps.12:6, 119:140, Pr.30:5, Rom.14:20, Ph.4:8,*
but even their mind and **conscience** (*1 Tim.3:9*)
is **defiled**. *1 Cor.8:7*

Verse 16:

16 They **profess** that they know God; *1 Tim.6:12*
but in works they deny him,
being **abominable**, *FM: Lev.7:21,11:43, Pr.15:26, 28:9*
and disobedient,
and unto every good work **reprobate**. *FM: Jer.6:30,*
Rom.1:28, 2 Tim.3:8
