- 4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared,
- 5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- 6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;
- 7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
- 8 This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.

Verses 4 & 5:

4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man **appeared**, 2:11

5 **Not by works** of righteousness which we have done, 2 Tim. 1:9-10, Rom.9:11, 11:6, Gal.2:16

but according to **his mercy** he saved us, *Eph.2:4, 8-9* by the washing of **regeneration**, *Matt.19:28* and **renewing** of the Holy Ghost; *Rom.12:2*

Verses 6 & 7:

- 6 Which he **shed** on us **abundantly** through Jesus Christ our Saviour; Rom.5:5, *Jn.* 10:10, Eph.3:20
- 7 That being **justified** by his grace, *Rom.3:24* we should be made heirs according to the **hope of eternal life**. 1:2, Rom.3:25

Verse 8:

8 This is a **faithful saying**, 1:9, 1 Tim.1:15, and these things I will that thou **affirm** constantly, Rom.3:8, 1 Tim.1:7 – see also Ac. 25:19, Lk. 22:59 that they which have believed in God might be careful to **maintain good works**. 3:1,14

These things are good and **profitable** unto men. 1 Tim.4:8, 2 Tim.3:16, Phil. v11
