7 For we have great joy and consolation in thy love, because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by thee, brother.

8 Wherefore, though I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin thee that which is convenient,

9 Yet for love's sake I rather beseech thee, being such an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ.

Verse 7:

7 For we have great joy and consolation

(Je.16:7, Ac.4:36, 2 Co. 1:5-6,Ph.2:1)

in **thy love**, *v5*

because the **bowels** (Ge. 15:4, Nu. 5:22, 2 Sa. 20:10, Ps.40:8, Lk.1:78, Ph.2:1)

of the saints are **refreshed** (2 Ti.1:16, Phm.20) by thee, brother.

Verse 8: 8 Wherefore, though I might be much **bold** in Christ (*Pr.28:1*) to **enjoin** thee (*enjoined – Es.9:31, Job 36:23, He.9:20*) that which is **convenient**, *2 Sam.18:22, Pr. 30:8*,

1 Cor. 16:12

Verse 9:

9 Yet for love's sake (Ps.25:7, Eph.4:32)

I rather **beseech** thee, *Ac.21:39, 2 Co.10:1-2,*1 Th.4:1, Phm.v10

being such an one as Paul the **aged**, *Job 12:20, He.5:14,*

and now also a **prisoner** of Jesus Christ. v1
