Heaven - 1. By The Numbers

- 1. Heaven is found 595 times in 552 verses. Poss. case once heaven's Matt. 19:12
- 2. How Many Bible Books Mention Heaven? 52 of 66
- 3. Which Bible Books don't mention Heaven?
- Numbers, Ruth, Esther, Song of Solomon, Joel, Micah, Habakkuk = 7 OT
- 5. 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Philemon, 2 John, 3 John, Jude = 7 NT
- Which Book has the Most Mention of Heaven? Matthew = 69x (OT = Deut. 34x)
- Which verse has the Most Frequent Mention of Heaven? OT = Deut. 4:19, Neh. 9:6 NT = Matt. 16:19, Jn. 3:13, Ac.1:11
- 8. The Book of Revelation has the highest Ratio per Word = (56/11995) .46

Heaven – 2. First & Last Mention

First Mention:

- Gen. 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- Last Mention:
 - Rev. 21:10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

Heaven – 3. Definitions

Hebrew - Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 8064. שַׁמַיִם shamayim

shaw-mah'-yim dual of an unused singular shameh {shaw-meh'}; from an unused root meaning to be lofty; the sky (as aloft; the dual perhaps alluding to the visible arch in which the clouds move, as well as to the higher ether where the celestial bodies revolve):—air, X astrologer, heaven(-s).

Greek - Strong's Greek Dictionary 3772. oupavoç ouranos oupavoç ouranos oo-ran-os' perhaps from the same as 3735 (through the idea of elevation); the sky; by extension, heaven (as the abode of God); by implication, happiness, power, eternity; specially, the Gospel (Christianity):—air, heaven(-ly), sky.

English - heaven /0'hɛv(ə)n/ noun. OE. [ORIGIN Old English heofon, earlier hefen, heben, corresp. to Old Saxon hean, Old Norse himinn (inflected stem hifn-), Gothic himins; parallel formations with I- suffix are Old Frisian himul, Old Saxon, Old High German himil (Dutch hemel, German Himmel); ult. origin unkn.]

- 3. Glory Phil. 4:19, Col.3:4, 1 Tim. 3:16 Only Paul uses this term.
