Hell - 1. By The Numbers

- 1. Hell is found 61 times across 56 verses including footnotes
- 2. How Many Bible Books Mention Hell? 18 of 66
- 3. Which Bible Books do mention Hell?
 - Deuteronomy, 2 Samuel, Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Isaiah, Ezekiel, Amos, Jonah, Habakkuk = 10 OT (29 do not)
 - Matthew, Mark, Luke, Acts, 1 Corinthians*, James, 2 Peter, Revelation = 8 NT (19 do not)
- 4. Which Book has the **Most Mention** of Hell?
 - 1. OT: Psalms = 8 verses; 6 in the text, + 3 footnotes.
 - 2. NT: Matthew = 9 verses; 6 in the text, + 3 footnotes.
- 5. Which verses have the highest **Frequency** of Hell?
 - 1. OT: Ps. 55:15 = 1 + fn, Ps. 86:13 = 1 + fn, Is. 14:9 = 1 + fn, Jon. 2:2 = 1 + fn,
 - 2. NT: Rev. 20:13 = 1 + fn.
- 6. The Book of Jonah has the highest **Ratio** by word count 2/1320 (.15)

Hell – 2. First & Last Mention

- **►** First Mention:
 - **Deut. 32:22** For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest **hell**, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.
- Last Mention:
 - Rev. 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Hell – 3. Definitions

- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 7585. שְׁאוֹל sh@'owl sheh-ole' or shol {sheh-ole'}; from 7592; Hades or the world of the dead (as if a subterranean retreat), including its accessories and inmates:—grave, hell, pit.
- Used 65 times in OT, and is translated as Grave (31x); Hell (31x); and Pit (3x)
- Strong's Greek Dictionary 1067. γεεννα geenna γεεννα geenna gheh'-en-nah of Hebrew origin (1516 and 2011); valley of (the son of) Hinnom; ge-henna (or Ge-Hinnom), a valley of Jerusalem, used (figuratively) as a name for the place (or state) of everlasting punishment:—hell.
- Used 12x in the NT translated as Hell in all 12.
- Strong's Greek Dictionary 86. Aδης hades Aδης hades hah'-dace from 1 (as negative particle) and 1492; properly, unseen, i.e. "Hades" or the place (state) of departed souls:—grave, hell.
- SOED hell /0hɛl/ noun. OE. [ORIGIN Old English hel(I) = Old Frisian helle, Old Saxon hell(j)a (Dutch hel), Old High German hella (German Hölle), Old Norse hel, Gothic halja from Germanic base meaning 'cover, conceal': see hele verb.]
 - 1 (Often H-.) The abode of the dead; the place of departed spirits; the infernal regions regarded as a place of existence after death, the kingdom of Hades. OE. ► b The kingdom or power of hell; collect. the inhabitants, wicked spirits, or powers of hell. ME. ► c A devilish assembly. Long rare. L16.
 - 2 (Often H-.) The infernal regions regarded as a place of torment or punishment; the abode of devils and condemned spirits. Freq. as an interjection or in exclamatory phrs. expr. annoyance, incredulity, dismay, etc., or merely emphatic (cf. heck noun²). OE.

Hell- 4. Other Names for Hell

- 1. Tophet Is. 30:33 For Tophet is ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made it deep and large: the pile thereof is fire and much wood; the breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, doth kindle it.
- 2. The Nether Parts Ezek. 31:14 To the end that none of all the trees by the waters exalt themselves for their height, neither shoot up their top among the thick boughs, neither their trees stand up in their height, all that drink water: for they are all delivered unto death, to the nether parts of the earth, in the midst of the children of men, with them that go down to the pit.
- 3. Everlasting Fire Matt. 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:
- **4. Everlasting Habitations Lk. 16:9** And I say unto you, Make to yourselves friends of the mammon of unrighteousness; that, when ye fail, they may receive you into **everlasting habitations**.
- 5. The Deep Rom. 10:7 Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.)
- 6. Lake of Fire Rev. 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.
- 7. The Bottomless Pit Rev. 20:1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

- Hell fire Matt. 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
- Gates of Hell Matt. 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.
- Child of Hell Matt. 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.
- All Hell let Loose Rev. 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.
