# Noah - 1. By The Numbers

- Noah is found 54 times across 44 verses including the spelling Noe, (excluding Noah, the daughter of Zelophehad mentioned in Joshua & Numbers)
- 2. How Many Bible Books Mention Noah? 9 of 66
- 3. Which Bible Books have **Noah** in the text?
  - 1. OT: Genesis, 1 Chronicles, Isaiah, Ezekiel = 4 (35 do not)
  - 2. NT: Matthew, Luke, (Noe)Hebrews, 1 & 2 Peter = 5 (22 do not)
- 4. Which Book has the **Most Mention** of **Noah**?
  - 1. Genesis = 41 times across 35 verses
- 5. Which verses have the highest Frequency of Noah?
  - 1. Gen. 6:9 = 3
  - 2. Gen. 7:13 = 3
- The Book of Genesis has the highest Ratio by word count 41/38262 (.10%)

# Noah – 2. First & Last Mention

### First Mention:

■ **Gen. 5:29** And he called his name **Noah**, saying, This same shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed.

### Last Mention:

2 Pet. 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

# Noah - 3. Definitions

- Nogh defined in the Bible text:
  - **Gen. 5:29** And he called his name **Noah**, saying, This same shall **comfort** us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed.
- Defined in the KJB Footnote at Gen.5:29:
  - Noah: Gr. Noe: That is Rest, or, Comfort
- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 5146. אַ Noach no'-akh the same as 5118; rest; Noach, the patriarch of the flood:—Noah.
- Strong's Greek Dictionary 3575. Nωε Noe no'-eh of Hebrew origin (5146); Noe, (i.e. Noach), a patriarch:—Noe.
- **SOED Noah** /0'nəʊə/ noun. Earlier †Noe. OE. [ORIGIN Biblical patriarch repr. as 10th in descent from Adam (Genesis 6 ff).]

## Noah – 4. The Generations of Noah

- 28 And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son:
- 29 And he called his name Noah, saying, This same shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed.
- 30 And Lamech lived after he begat Noah five hundred ninety and five years, and begat sons and daughters:
  - **31** And all the days of Lamech were seven hundred seventy and seven years: and he died.
- 32 And Noah was five hundred years old: and Noah begat Shem, Ham, and Japheth. Gen.5:28-32
- 9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.
- 10 And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth. Gen.6:9&10

## Noah – 5. God's Covenant with Noah

- 13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.
- **14** Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.
- 15 And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.
- **16** A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; with lower, second, and third stories shalt thou make it.
- 17 And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, from under heaven; and every thing that is in the earth shall die.
- **18** But with thee will I **establish my covenant**; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee.
- 19 And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every sort shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee; they shall be male and female.
- **20** Of fowls after their kind, and of cattle after their kind, of every creeping thing of the earth after his kind, two of every sort shall come unto thee, to keep them alive.
- 21 And take thou unto thee of all food that is eaten, and thou shalt gather it to thee; and it shall be for food for thee, and for them.
- 22 Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he. Gen.6:13-22

### Noah – 6. The Token of God's Covenant

8 And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying,

9 And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you;

10 And with every living creature that is with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth.

11 And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth.

12 And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations:

13 I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.

**14** And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud:

15 And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.


16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth.

17 And God said unto Noah, This is the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that is upon the earth. Gen.9:8-17

## Noah - 7. The Faith of Noah

- 6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
- 7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
  Heb. 11:6&7
- What is Faith?
  - Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Heb.11:1
  - Substance FM: Gen.7:4
  - Evidence FM: Jer. 32:10
