Canaan - 1. By The Numbers

- 1. Land of Canaan is found 66 times across 64 verses. It is named after Canaan , a son of Ham: Gen.9:18
- 2. How Many Bible Books have the phrase 11 of 66 (17%)
- 3. Which Bible Books have it in the text?
 - A. OT: Gen, Ex., Lev., Num., Deut., Jos., Jud., 1 Chr., Ps., Ez.
 - B. NT: Ac. (Chanaan) Ac. 7:11, 13:19,
 - C. Canaan is found in Matt. 15:22.
- 4. Which Book has the Most Mention?

Gen = **34**

5. Most Mention in one verse – two locations:

Gen.12:5 And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the **land of Canaan**; and into the **land of Canaan** they came.

Num. 34:2 Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land of Canaan; (this is the land that shall fall unto you for an inheritance, even the land of Canaan with the coasts thereof:)

Canaan – 2. Definitions

Canaan is defined in the Bible text:

- **Zeph. 2:5** Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD *is* against you; O **Canaan**, the **land of the Philistines**, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.

First Mention:

Gen. 11:31 And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife; and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, to go into the land of Canaan; and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there.

Last Mention:

Ez. 16:3 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD unto Jerusalem; Thy birth and thy nativity is of the land of Canaan; thy father was an Amorite, and thy mother an Hittite.
