Egypt - 1. By The Numbers

- 1. Egypt is found 614 times across 560 verses
- 2. How Many Bible Books mention Egypt? 32 of 66 (48%)
- 3. Which Bible Books have **Egypt** in the text?
 - A. OT: 27 of 39 do; those that do not: Ruth, Ezra, Esther, Job, Ecc. Song, Lam., Ob., Jon, Hab. 69%
 - B. NT: 5 of 27 do; Matt., Ac., Heb., Jude, Rev. 18%
- 4. Which Book has the Most Mention?

Exodus = 110

5. Most Mention in one verse:

Is. 19:1 The burden of **Egypt**. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into **Egypt**: and the idols of **Egypt** shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of **Egypt** shall melt in the midst of it.

Egypt – 2. Definitions

Egypt is defined in the Bible text:

- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 4714. מְצְרַיִם Mitsrayim mits-rah'-yim dual of 4693; Mitsrajim, i.e. Upper and Lower Egypt:—Egypt, Egyptians, Mizraim.
- Mizraim Gen. 10:6 And the sons of Ham; Cush, and Mizraim, and Phut, and Canaan. Strong's Greek Dictionary 125. Αιγυπτος Aiguptos ah'-ee-goop-tos of uncertain derivation:—Ægyptus, the land of the Nile:—Egypt.
- **The land of Ham –** Ps. 78:51, 103:23,27
- SOED Egyptian /01'd31p∫(a)n/ adjective & noun. ME. [ORIGIN from Egypt (see below) + -ian.]
- ► A adjective.
- 1 Of, pertaining to, or native to Egypt, a country in NE Africa. Also, of or pertaining to the language Egyptian (see below). ME.

Egypt – 3. First & Last Mention

First Mention:

■ **Gen. 12:10** And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into **Egypt** to sojourn there; for the famine was grievous in the land.

Last Mention:

■ Rev. 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. .




EGYPTIAN GEOGRAPHY

North-East Africa.

Lower Egypt (N), around the delta, a plain and marsh territory.

Upper Egypt (S), arid land where life is only possible next to the river.





5. Who Came Out of Egypt?

- Jos. 24:32 And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.
- 2 Chron. 5:10 There was nothing in the ark save the two tables which Moses put therein at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt.
- Hos. 12:13 And by a prophet the LORD brought Israel out of Egypt, and by a prophet was he preserved.
- Hos. 11:1 When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.
- Matt. 2:15 And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son.
