Moses - 1. By The Numbers

- 1. Moses is found 855 times across 784 verses and Footnotes
- 2. How Many Bible Books have Moses? 31 of 66 (47%)
- 3. Which Bible Books have Moses in the text?
 - A. OT: Ex., Lev., Num., Deut., Jos., Jud., 1 Sam., 1 & 2 Ki., 1 & 2 Chr., Ezr., Neh., Ps., Is., Jer., Dan., Mic., Mal. = 19 (20 do not) 49%
 B. NT: Matt., Mk., Lk., Jn., Ac., Rom., 1 & 2 Cor., 2 Tim., Heb., Ju., Rev. = 12 (15 do not) 44%
- Which Book has the Most Mention?
 Ex. = 261
- 5. Which verses have the **most matches**?

Ex. 34:29, 34:55 & Lev. 8:29 (3x each)

Moses – 2. Definitions

Moses is defined in the Bible text at his first mention:

- Ex. 2:10 And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water.
- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 4872. מֹשֶׁה Mosheh mo-sheh' from 4871; drawing out (of the water), i.e. rescued; Mosheh, the Israelite lawgiver:—Moses.
- Strong's Strong's Greek Dictionary3475. Μωσευς Moseus moce-yoos' or Moses mo-sace', or Mouses mo-oo-sace' of Hebrew origin; (4872); Moseus, Moses, or Mouses (i.e. Mosheh), the Hebrew lawgiver:—Moses.
- SOED Moses /0'məuzız/ noun. E16. [ORIGIN Ecclesiastical Latin Moses, Moyses, Ecclesiastical Greek Mösēs, from Hebrew Möšeh. In sense 4 prob. alt. of mimosa.]

Moses – 3. First & Last Mention

First Mention:

Ex. 2:10 And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

Last Mention:

Rev. 15:3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.

Moses – 4. The Servitude of Moses

- 1. Moses served his Step-Father forty years in Egypt -Ac.7:23
- 2. Moses served his Father-in-law forty years in Midian Ac.7:29
- Moses served his Heavenly Father forty years in the wilderness Ac. 7:36
 Deut. 34:7 And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: his eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.

Moses – 5. God's Covenant With Moses

Ex. 34:27 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write thou these words: for after the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with thee and with Israel.

Moses – 6. The Tokens of God's Covenant

7 And the LORD said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows;

8 And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

9 Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them.

10 Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

11 And Moses said unto God, Who am I, that I should go unto Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt?

12 And he said, Certainly I will be with thee; and this shall be a **token** unto thee, that I have sent thee: When thou hast brought forth the people out of Egypt, ye shall serve God upon this mountain.

13 And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them?

14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations. **Ex. 3:7-15**

Moses – 7. The Faith of Moses

23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

26 Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.

27 By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

28 Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

29 By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned. **Heb. 11:23-29**
