1. By The Numbers

- The name Jesus is found 984 times across 943 verses, including footnotes. OT = 1x; NT 983x
- 2. How Many Bible Books have Jesus 27 of 66 (41%)
- 3. Which OT Books have Jesus in the text? 0 Ex. 17:9 Margin

Ex. 17:9 And Moses said unto **Joshua**, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand. *FN*: Called Jesus Ac.7:45, He. 4:8

- 1. Which **NT** Books don't have **Jesus** in them? 3 John
- 2. Verse Match Count by book? John = 245 (24.9%)
- 3. Phrase Match Frequency by Book = John 256 26.02 of the total
- 4. Which verse has the **most matches**? John 19:38 = 3

And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of **Jesus**, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of **Jesus**: and Pilate gave *him* leave. He came therefore, and took the body of **Jesus**. Jn.19:38

First Mention:

Matthew 1:1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Last Mention:

Rev. 22:21 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.

3. Definitions

Jesus is Defined in the Bible Text itself:

Matt. 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call

his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. FN: That is, Saviour, Heb.

Saviour – Strong's Greek Dictionary 4990. σωτήρ soter (sōtér) so-tare' from <u>G4982</u>; a deliverer, i.e. God or Christ:—saviour. masculine noun

Lk. 1:47 And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

- Son of God Mk 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;
- Strong's Hebrew Dictionary 3091. אָהוֹשׁוּעַ Yehowshuwa (Yehôwshûwa'). yeh-ho-shoo'-ah or אָהוֹשֶׁע Yehôwshu'a; from <u>H3068</u> and <u>H3467</u>; Jehovah-saved; Jehoshua (i.e. Joshua), the Jewish leader:—Jehoshua, Jehoshuah, Joshua. proper masculine noun
- Strong's Greek Dictionary 2424. Ἰησοῦς lesous (lēsoûs), ee-ay-sooce' of Hebrew origin (<u>H3091</u>); Jesus (i.e. Jehoshua), the name of our Lord and two (three) other Israelites:—Jesus. proper masculine noun

4. The Lord Jesus Christ in Prophecy

Is. 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:

2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
3 And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

4 But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.

5 And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.
6 The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them.

Is. 53:1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? **2** For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, *there is* no beauty that we should desire him.

3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

5. The Lord Jesus Christ in His Humanity

A. Born of a Virgin -

- A. Is. 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.
- **B. Matt. 1:23** Behold, **a virgin** shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.
- C. Lk. 1:27 To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.
- B. Made as a Man
 - A. 1 Tim. 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.
 - B. Matt. 18:11 For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.

5. The Lord Jesus Christ in His Humanity

C. Made under the Law -

- A. Gal. 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,
- B. 1 Cor. 9:20 And unto the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might gain the Jews; to them that are under the law, as under the law, that I might gain them that are under the law; 21 To them that are without law, as without law, (being not without law to God, but under the law to Christ,) that I might gain them that are without law.
- D. Came to his Own Jn. 1:11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.
- E. Humiliated Ac. 8:33 In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? for his life is taken from the earth.
- F. The Curse Gal. 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: Deut. 21:23

Ps.148:13 Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven.

- Prov. 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?
- Is. 12:4 And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted.
- Jer. 23:6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

6.a The Lord Jesus Christ in His Glory

A. At His Transfiguration:

Lk. 9:28 And it came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, he took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray.

29 And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment was white and glistering.

30 And, behold, there talked with him two men, which were Moses and Elias:

31 Who appeared **in glory**, and spake of his decease which he should accomplish at Jerusalem.

32 But Peter and they that were with him were heavy with sleep: and when they were awake, they saw **his glory**, and the two men that stood with him.

33 And it came to pass, as they departed from him, Peter said unto Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias: not knowing what he said.

34 While he thus spake, there came a cloud, and overshadowed them: and they feared as they entered into the cloud.

35 And there came a voice out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.

36 And when the voice was past, Jesus was found alone. And they kept it close, and told no man in those days any of those things which they had seen.

6.b The Lord Jesus Christ in His Glory

B. In His Humiliation

Jn. 12:23 And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should **be glorified**.

Jn. 17:1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; **glorify thy Son**, that thy Son also may **glorify thee**:

4 I have **glorified thee** on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

5 And now, O Father, **glorify thou me** with thine own self with **the glory** which I had with thee before the world was. (see Jn. 1:1)

6.c The Lord Jesus Christ in His Glory

C. At His Resurrection

Ac. 3:13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath **glorified his Son Jesus**; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

1 Cor. 15:40 There are also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial *is* one, and the glory of the terrestrial *is* another.

41 There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars: for one star differeth from another star in glory.

42 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:

43 It is sown in dishonour; it is **raised in glory**: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

6.d The Lord Jesus Christ in His Glory

D. In His Kingdom

Ps. 102:16 When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear **in his glory**.

Matt. 25:31 When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

7.a The Faith of The Lord Jesus Christ

A. His Faith:

- 1. Without faith But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Heb. 11:6 *cf.*, *Rom.8*:8
- 2. But now But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: Rom. 3:21-22
- 3. By Faith Who's Faith? Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. Gal. 2:16
- 4. Found In Him And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: Phi. 3:9

7.b The Faith of The Lord Jesus Christ

- B. His Righteousness
- 1. None Righteous As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: Rom.3:20, Ps.14:1-3, Is.64:6
- How might I be Just? I know it is so of a truth: but how should man be just with God? Job 9:2, 25:4
- 3. Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare **his righteousness** for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time **his righteousness**: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. Rom. 3:25-26
- 4. Justified by Faith Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law. Rom. 3:28, 5:1
