2 Background of Romans

A. Background of the letter

- 1. Written by the Apostle Paul "to all that be in Rome" (1:7), during his third missionary journey (probably from Corinth Acts.20:1-3, around 57-58 AD. See also 18:18 with Rom. 16:3. Paul wrote to the Romans before he ever went to Rome (Rom. 1:13).
- 2. Sixth book in the New Testament. Six is the number of Man Gen. 1:26-31. Joshua sixth book in OT
- 3. 45th book in the Bible. Compare Is. 45:9 with Rom. 9:20,

Is. 45:15 with Rom. 11:7, Is. 45:23 with Rom. 14:11,

Is. 45:25 with Rom. 4:25.

3 Background of Romans

- 1 Romans
- 2 4:25 Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.
 - 9:20 Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed *it*, Why hast thou made me thus?
 - 11:7 What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded
 - 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.
- 3 Isaiah chapter 45
- 4 25 In the LORD shall all the seed of Israel be justified, and shall glory.
 - 9 Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! *Let* the potsherd *strive* with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?
 - 15 Verily thou art a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, the Saviour.
 - 23 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth *in* righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.

- 4. The book of Romans establishes the believer doctrinally 2 Tim. 3:16
- 5. The letter has 16 chapters, 433 verses containing 9,857 words.
- 6. He appealed unto Caesar (Acts 25: 11) and began his voyage to Rome (Acts 27:1).
- 7. Paul asks 88 questions of the reader. For example:

What advantage then hath the Jew? (3:1)

For what saith the scripture? (4:3)

Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? (6:1)
