2 **Lesson 9 Romans 2: 1-6**

1. Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things. 2. But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things. 3. And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God? 4. Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? 5. But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God; 6. Who will render to every man according to his deeds:

Verse 1:

Therefore thou art inexcusable, (UW 1x in KJB)

O man, (41x, 6th word 6 times in a sentence. 2:1, 2:3, 2:6, 3:28, 5:7, 6:6)

whosoever thou art that judgest:

for wherein thou judgest another,

thou condemnest thyself;

for thou that judgest doest the same things. 3X in the same context, 1:32, 2:1, 2:3

4 **Unique Word #76 Inexcusable**

#76 Inexcusable. This word appears once in the KJB.

• Inexcusable is defined for the reader in the previous chapter in Romans:

"For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:" Rom. 1:20

Verses 2 and 3:

2. But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things.

3. And thinkest thou this, O man,

that judgest them which do such things,

and doest the same,

that thou shalt escape the judgment of God? (1 Cor. 11:31)

Judgment of God- 3x same context 1:32, 2:3, 2:5,

Verses 4 and 5:

4. Or despisest thou the riches (Eph.1:7, Col.1:27) of his goodness and forbearance and

longsuffering; (3:25)

not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? (Ps.52:1, Rom. 11:22)

5. But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

- Hardness-1Sam. 6:6, Ez. 3:7
- Impenitent-UW #71. Not penitent. See next slide
- Day of wrath-FM: Job 21:30, Prov. 11:4, Zeph. 1:15

7 **Unique Word #71 Impenitent**

#71 Impenitent. This word appears once in the KJB.

- Rom. 2:5 "But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;"
- Ward Allen has *impenitent* coming from the Rheims NT; however, Miles Coverdale provided the word first in 1535 but reverted to *cannot repent* in the Great Bible of 1541. The closest word prior to *impenitent* was Wycliffe (1390) –*vnrepentaunt*.
