2 Romans Lesson 14 3:1-8

1 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit *is there* of circumcision? 2 Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God. 3 For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? 4 God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged. 5 But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of God, what shall we say? *Is* God unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (I speak as a man) 6 God forbid: for then how shall God judge the world? 7 For if the truth of God hath more abounded through my lie unto his glory; why yet am I also judged as a sinner? 8 And not *rather*, (as we be slanderously reported, and as some affirm that we say,) Let us do evil, that good may come? whose damnation is just. 3 Romans Lesson 14 3:1-8

Verse 1 - 2:

1 What advantage then hath the Jew? (FM: Job.35:3) or what profit *is there* of circumcision? (FM: Gen.27:12)

2 Much every way: (much more 11:12,24, Lk. 12:48) chiefly,

because that unto them were committed the oracles of God. FM: Ac. 7:38 – written words of God. Plural used 4x. Heb.5:12, 1 Pe. 4:11.

Singular FM: 2 Sam. 16:23 – a word and a place 1 Ki. 6:5, 19-23

Verses 3-4:

3 For what if some did not believe? (10:16, Heb.4:2) shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? (2 Tim.2:13)

4 God forbid: (10x in Romans)

yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; (Ps. 62:9,116:11)

as it is written, (Ps.51:4) 14x in Romans

That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

Verses 5-6:

5 But if our unrighteousness commend the (5:8) righteousness of God, what shall we say? (6:1)

Is God unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (I speak as a man) Job 8:3, Is. 45:21, Gal.3:15

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6 God forbid: (6:2)

for then how shall God judge the world? Ps.7:9

Verses 7-8:

7 For if the truth of God hath more abounded (5:20) through my lie unto his glory; why yet am I also judged as a sinner? (Gal.2:15)

8 And not *rather*, (as we be slanderously reported, and as some affirm that we say,) Let us do evil, that good may come? (13:4) whose damnation is just.
