16 ☐ **Romans Lesson 20 4:9-13**

9 *Cometh* this blessedness then upon the circumcision *only*, or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness. 10 How was it then reckoned? when he was in circumcision, or in uncircumcision? Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision. 11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had yet* being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also: 12 And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which *he had* being *yet* uncircumcised. 13 For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, *was* not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Verse 9:

9 *Cometh* this blessedness then upon the circumcision *only*, (3:30)

or upon the uncircumcision also? (Gal.3:8-9)

for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness. (15:21-23, 2 Tim.2:7)

Verse 10:

10 How was it then reckoned?

when he was in circumcision,

or in uncircumcision?

Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision.

19 ☐ **Romans Lesson 20 4:9-13**

Verse 11:

11 And he received the sign of circumcision, (Gen.17:11)

a seal of the righteousness of the faith which *he had yet* being uncircumcised: (Compare with our seal, Eph.1:13)

that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; (4:1)

that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:

Verse 12:

12 And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only,

but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham,

which *he had* being *yet* uncircumcised.

21 ☐ **Romans Lesson 20 4:9-13**

13 For the promise, (Ac. 7:3, 17)
that he should be the heir of the world,
was not to Abraham,
or to his seed, through the law,
but through the righteousness of faith.
