Verses 19-20:

19 And being not weak in faith, (v.21)

he considered not his own body now dead, (Heb.11:12)

when he was about an hundred years old, (Gen.17:17,24)

neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: (Gen.18:11, Heb.11:11)

20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; (Job 12:25-26, Ps.107:27)

but was strong in faith, (v. 19)

giving glory to God;

Verse 22:

21 And being fully persuaded that, (14:5, Ac.28:23, 2 Cor. 5:11)

what he had promised,

he was able also to perform. (Gen.18:14)

22 And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. (v.6, 8, 11)

32 Romans Lesson 22 4:19-25

Verses 23-24:

23 Now it was not written for his sake alone,

that it was imputed to him;

24 But for us also, (15:4)

to whom it shall be imputed,

if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;

Verse 25: 25 Who was delivered for our offences, (ls.53:5-6) and was raised again (1 Cor.15:17) for our justification. (5:18)
