Verses 5-6:

5 And hope maketh not ashamed; (Ps.119:116, Php. 1:20)

because the love of God is shed abroad (Mk.4:22)

in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

6 For when we were yet without strength, (Lam.1:6)

in due time Christ died for the ungodly. (1 Tim. 2:6, 1 Cor. 15:8, Ti. 1:3)

15 Romans Lesson 24 5:5-10

Verse 7-8:

7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die:

(FM: Gen. 27:30, 1 Pet. 4:18)

yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. (2 Tim.2:25)

8 But God commendeth his love toward us, (2 Cor.2:18)

in that, while we were yet sinners, (Eph.2:5)

Christ died for us. (Gal.1:4)

Verses 9-10:

9 Much more then, (v10, 15, 17, 20, 11:12, and 11:24)

being now justified by his blood, (3:25)

we shall be saved from wrath through him. (1 Th. 5:9)

10 For if, when we were enemies, (Col.1:21, Php.3:18)

we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son,

much more, (5:15, 20)

being reconciled, (2 Cor. 5:18-20, Eph. 2:16)

we shall be saved by his life.
