22 Romans Lesson 28 6:6-10

6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with *him*, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. 7 For he that is dead is freed from sin. 8 Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: 9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. 10 For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Verses 6-7:

6 Knowing this,

that our old man (Eph. 4:22, Col. 3:9)

is crucified with him, (Gal. 2:20 & 5:24)

that the body of sin might be destroyed, (Col. 2:11)

that henceforth we should not serve sin. (v.16)

7 For he that is dead is freed from sin. (v.18)

Verses 8-9:

8 Now if we be dead with Christ, (2 Cor. 4:10)

we believe that we shall also live with him: (2 Tim. 2:11)

9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead (Acts 3:15, 4:10, 2 Tim. 2:8)

dieth no more; (v.10, Rev. 20:6,14)

death hath no more dominion over him. (Acts 2:24)

Verse 10:

10 For in that he died,

he died unto sin once: (Heb. 7:27, 9:12, 9:28, 10:10, 1 Pe 3:18)

but in that he liveth,

he liveth unto God. (Gal. 2:19)
