

## June 2021 Prayer Letter

Hello again. I hope this letter finds all of you healthy and able to faithfully serve our Saviour.

We were able to make our trip to Mexico in April. While we did get a lot accomplished, we must go back at least one more time. It was a bittersweet trip. We met with Luis' family. Luis died from Covid. When he left for the hospital, it was the last time his family saw him. This disease has affected so many families in this way. Luis was a good friend and helper for me.

Gregorio, the pastor whose church did my paperwork thus making me 'legal' to minister in Mexico, also had Covid several months ago. He is suffering from some of its effects. He cannot raise his left hand above shoulder level.

There is a trailer park here that is mostly full of Hispanic folks, and I have started visiting in the area and passing out tracts. These folks are from all over South America. They are hard workers and make more in a day than they made in a week back in their home countries. Most tell me that they do not attend a church. As I mentioned before, many are in the U.S. illegally and are skeptical of an Anglo who speaks Spanish. Please pray for these folks and our efforts in trying to reach them for Christ. We are grateful that God has enabled us to give them the gospel in their birth language.
