Verses 9-10:

9 For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, (Rom 8:34, 1 Cor. 15:1-4) that he might be Lord both of the dead and living. (Ac 10:36, 42)

10 But why dost thou judge thy brother? (14:13) or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? (FM: Gen 29:15, 2 Th 3:8) for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. (2 Cor. 5:10)
