Leta Miller Update

As mentioned in our last News & Prayer Letter Leta has been seriously ill from COVID-19 and it's after, side effects. In October she was deemed well enough to go to our local hospital that specializes in rehabilitation. After two weeks the day came for her to go home. We were so excited. All the prayers of God's people around the world kept both of us going. There can be no doubt Leta's survival and healing was a miracle. She was so excited to come home to her own bed. The following day Leta had a pre-arranged appointment with our local doctor for a check-up on a leg wound she had back in March. On the day the nurse and doctor were not happy with Leta's appearance and her oxygen level. The decision was made to call an ambulance [which upset Leta greatly] to admit her back into hospital. Back in hospital they did the whole gambit of X-rays, CT and MRI scan's which showed she had a severe infection in her spine. That was the beginning of a six week nightmare. The Specialist told us that Leta would need six weeks of two intravenous



antibiotics which they began immediately. On day three Leta began to shake and her kidneys stopped working. She was having a serious reaction to one of the antibiotics. Her blood pressure dropped and she was readmitted to ICU. Our daughter Libby and I went in the first day at ICU to see Leta in a comatose state and looked like she was dying. The ICU Specialist took us to a room where he said he didn't know if Leta was going to survive. They were giving her large dosages of blood pressure medicine trying to get her blood pressure up so she could be connected to a dialysis machine. On day two her blood pressure was at a minimal place to allow dialysis. After four days of dialysis treatments her kidneys began to slowly recover. Her blood pressure began to rise and after a week in ICU she was moved back into the COVID infectious Ward. Many of you have been praying for my precious Leta. It's by the goodness and mercy of God that Leta has slowly recovered though she's very weak. Leta has had several Specialist working on her and her illness. One told me that in his 35 years of experience he had never had a patient that's been as ill for such a length of time as Leta. He told me that everyone on the ward loved Leta and had much respect for her. She's been a witness to all who have attended her. Many have asked about why we were in Scotland. One Consultant told her he was glad we started a Bible believing Baptist church in Scotland. I praise the Lord that this week, November 4, 2021, Leta was released from the main hospital in Aberdeen back to the local hospital for

rehabilitation. Her first stay at rehab took two weeks to get her up and walking. I believe this time it will take longer as she's very weak. However she is so happy to be where she is. Amen? Words can not express our gratitude and thanks to everyone. **A BIG THANK YOU** to everyone who have prayed, sent cards, and offerings to help. I'm sorry for not getting back to you. All along this journey I've been at the hospital every day from 10 AM until 6 PM. The hospital is an hours drive one way.
