7 Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me. 8 Greet Amplias my beloved in the Lord. 9 Salute Urbane, our helper in Christ, and Stachys my beloved. 10 Salute Apelles approved in Christ. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' *household*. 11 Salute Herodion my kinsman. Greet them that be of the *household* of Narcissus, which are in the Lord. 12 Salute Tryphena and Tryphosa, who labour in the Lord. Salute the beloved Persis, which laboured much in the Lord. Verse 7:

7 Salute Andronicus and Junia, (only mention)

my kinsmen, (FM: Ru 2:20, Rom 9:3)

and my fellowprisoners, (UW #51. Paul only. Col 4:10, Phm 23)

who are of note among the apostles, (2 Th 3:14)

who also were in Christ before me. (Jn 14:20, Gal 1:13,22)

# 19 Unique Word - Fellowprisoner

#51 Fellowprisoner. This word appears three times in the KJB, once in the plural and twice in the singular.

- Rom. 16:7 "Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me."
- Col. 4:10 "Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, (touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;)"
- Phlm. 23 "There salute thee Epaphras, my fellowprisoner in Christ Jesus;"

# 20 Unique Word - Fellowprisoner

\*Two words in the 1611 first edition. Hyphenated by Paris (1762) Cambridge Standard Edition. Made one word by Blayney (1769) Oxford Standard Edition.

Strong's Greek Dictionary 4869. συναιχμάλωτος (synaichmálōtos), soon-aheekh-mal'-o-tos from <u>G4862</u> and <u>G164</u>; a co-captive:—fellowprisoner. masculine noun. The Gk συναιχμάλωτος appears three times in the TR and translated fellowprisoners at Rom. 16:7, and as fellowprisoner at Col. 4:10 and Phlm. 23 in the KJB. JW.

10 Salute Apelles approved in Christ. (only mention)

Salute them which are of Aristobulus' household. (only mention of Aristobulus)

11 Salute Herodion my kinsman. (only mention)

Greet them that be of the *household* of Narcissus, (only mention)

which are in the Lord.

## 23 Romans Lesson 79 16:7-12

Verse 12:

12 Salute Tryphena and Tryphosa, (only mention of these two women)

who labour in the Lord.

Salute the beloved Persis, (only mention of this woman)

which laboured much in the Lord.
