## 40 2 Corinthians Lesson 6, 2:1-5

1 But I determined this with myself, that I would not come again to you in heaviness. 2 For if I make you sorry, who is he then that maketh me glad, but the same which is made sorry by me? 3 And I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, that my joy is *the joy* of you all. 4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you. 5 But if any have caused grief, he hath not grieved me, but in part: that I may not overcharge you all. 2 Corinthians 2:1-5

## Verses 1-2:

1 But I determined this with myself, (Ac 20:16, 1 Co 2:2) that I would not come again to you in heaviness. (1 Co 4:19, 16:6, 2 Co 1:23, 2:20, 13:2)

2 For if I make you sorry, (2 Co 7:8) who is he then that maketh me glad, but the same which is made sorry by me?

#### 42 2 Corinthians Lesson 6, 2:1-5

#### Verse 3:

3 And I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, (2 Co 12:21) I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, (2 Co 8:22, Ga 5:10, 2 Th 3:4, Phm 21) that my joy is *the joy* of you all. (Php 2:2, 4:1)

## 43 2 Corinthians Lesson 6, 2:1-5

Verse 4:

4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you (2 Co 7:8) with many tears; (Ac 20:31, 2 Ti 1:4, La 2:18, Jer 9:1, Ps 126:5-6) not that ye should be grieved, (7:9) but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you. (2 Co 12:15)

## 44 2 Corinthians Lesson 6, 2:1-5

Verse 5: 5 But if any have caused grief, (1 Co 5:1-2) he hath not grieved me, but in part: that I may not overcharge you all. (Lk 21:34)
