46  **2 Corinthians Lesson 7, 2:6-11**

Verses 6-7:

6 Sufficient to such a man *is* this punishment, (2 Co 7:5-7)  
which *was inflicted* of many. (1 Co 5:4)

7 So that contrariwise ye *ought* rather to forgive *him*, and comfort *him*, (Ga 6:1-2)  
lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. (Ps 35:25, Is 49:19)

Verses 8-9:

8 Wherefore I beseech you that ye would confirm *your* love toward him. (Ga 3:15)

9 For to this end also did I write,  
that I might know the proof of you, (2 Co 7:15, Php 2:12)  
whether ye be obedient in all things. (Pr 25:12)

49  **2 Corinthians Lesson 7, 2:6-11**

Verses 10-11:

10 To whom ye forgive any thing, I *forgive* also: (Eph 4:32)  
for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave *it*, (Col 3:13)  
for your sakes *forgave I it* in the person of Christ; (1 Co 4:6, 2 Co 4:15, 8:9)

11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: (1 Co 5:5, Lk 22:31, 1 Pe 5:8)  
for we are not ignorant of his devices. (FM: 2 Ch 2:14, Jer 18:11, Eph 6:11, 4:14)
