Hello!

We wanted to tell you about the trip to Venezuela that I have coming up, and to ask you to be praying.

I'll be heading down on Aug 18, and returning on Sept 19.

Visa work ... Believe it or not, I STILL have not been able to renew my visa! Each time I go down, the visa office informs me that there has still been no progress and that I need to wait. Then they give me a 90 day travel permit which allows me to return to the U.S. for up to 90 days. As long as I am back in Venezuela before the 90 days expire, my application is still valid. *** Please pray that I can finally get my visa!

Missions Conference... I'll be attending a missions conference. Together with some Yanomamö believers, we'll be sharing about the Yanomamö work with some Venezuelan churches and other missionaries that will be gathered for this event. *** Please pray for an encouraging and profitable time together. The churches in Venezuela want to be involved in helping the Yanomamö church move forward.

7 day seminar with the Yanomamö leaders... One of the churches will be hosting us as I go over the Bible lessons with the Yanomamö. I'll be explaining the logic behind using these lessons in teaching and asking them for help with the Yanomamö cultural issues we want to be addressing throughout the teaching program. *** Please be praying for wisdom and for good participation from the Yanomamö.

Flights to bring out the Yanomamö from the jungle... We will need to ask the Venezuelan military to make two flights for us. One to bring the Yanomamö out to town, and another to take them back home. We have the first flight taken care of and are working on raising the money for the second flight. *** Please be praying that God will provide the funds needed for the second flight.

Those are the main prayer requests for this trip. Thank you for praying!

*** I also want to add one last request here. I'd like to try to collect cell phones again like I did once before. Would you be willing to ask around to see if anyone would like to donate a cell phone? Maybe they are upgrading and have an extra phone around. Cell phones are a great gift for pastors and other Venezuelan co-workers, as well as a good tool for the Yanomamö since it gives them contact with us when they are out in town. The phones would need to not have a password (or else send us the password with it) And the phone would need to be UNLOCKED in order to work in Venezuela.
