Dear Pastors, Supporters & Praying Friends, I pray this **News & Prayer Letter** finds each of you well and blessed of our Lord. I usually send a Prayer & News Letter every two months however July is a special month for us and the ministry. It was July 1986 that the Miller family arrived in Scotland. That was 36 years ago. The Lord has blessed us and the ministry in so many ways. We’ve seen souls saved, baptised and a church established from scratch. After working a year in Glasgow with a veteran missionary we moved to Aberdeen. We had no contacts and we didn’t know a soul. I started preaching in downtown Aberdeen with my family passing out gospel tracts. By God’s grace we started the first independent, Bible believing, Baptist church in the whole of North Eastern part of Scotland. The nearest such church, missionaries, was over 150 miles south. Preaching in the open air was not recommended as a way to start a church but I have to say that’s how we started. The first soul saved, Fred Smith, was the result of receiving a gospel tract from my oldest son, Dennis. He is now the song leader and pulpit supply when needed. The following is a series of pictures beginning with our deputation to the present here in Scotland. I know some of you have never met us in person or face to face. I hope these pictures will be an introduction to you. For those of you who have known us from the beginning I pray you will be blessed. We want to thank all of you who have supported and prayed for us over the years. God bless you all.
