Transformed, transforming. This word appears four times in the KJB in two different forms. Transform originated with GEN at 2 Cor. 11:13, 14 and 15. It was subsequently used by the KJB translators at Rom. 12:2 and the same verses in 2 Cor. 11. See Table 166 below. It is worth noting here also that MS98 had transformed in the first part of Rom.12:2, but the KJB translators selected the RHE conformed instead. For more on conformed see #29 conformed.

The KJB defines transform at Phil.3:21:

"Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself."

Strong's Greek Dictionary 3345. μετασχηματιζω metaschematizo *met-askh-ay-mat-id'-zo* from 3326 and a derivative of 4976; to transfigure or disguise; figuratively, to apply (by accommodation): — transfer, transform (self). *The GK μετασχηματιζω is used five times in the TR and is translated once as transferred at 1 Cor.4:6 in the KJB. The other four times it is translated as transforming (2 Cor.11:13), transformed (2 Cor.11:14 and 15), and as shall change (Phil. 3:21). See previous word, #165 Transferred. JW.*
