I rejoice to start this News & Prayer Letter with rejoicing and praising the Lord. Anna, wife of Jakub, got saved this past Sunday morning. The family are from Poland and have lived in our area for just over a year. Jakub was encouraged to find a Baptist church to attend when he left Poland. Raised a Roman Catholic, he was disillusioned with what was going on in the RC Church. Jakub found us online and visited. The first Sunday he visited I preached on the conversion of the Ethiopian eunuch in Acts 8. Jakub came to me after the service and asked if I would “guide” him in understanding the Scriptures. I showed him what the Bible said about salvation and he got saved that morning. He asked us to pray for his wife, Anna. She was very zealous in the Catholic Church and viewed Baptist as a cult. We prayed vigorously for Anna for a few months before she finally visited the church. I noticed she was bringing a Bible with her. She followed me in her Bible while I preached. One Sunday I preached on Paul’s testimony of his salvation to King Agrippa from Acts 26:28. I spoke about Festus, Felix and Drusilla in Acts 24 how Felix trembled and said, “Go thy way for this time: when I have a convenient season, I will call for thee.” Emphasising that he never got saved! I closed my message with

Acts 26:28 “Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian.” What a blessing to have Anna come to me after the service and asked me to explain salvation to her. Within minutes the angels in heaven were rejoicing.

Care Home Ministry

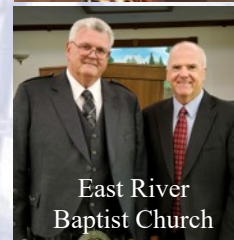
We continue to have great services at the Garioch Care Home. Numbers are good. Singing and the spirit is always great.

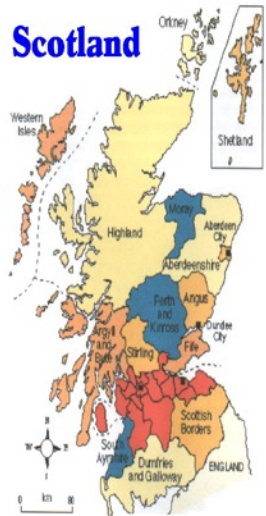
