13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: 14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. 15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death. 16 Do not err, my beloved brethren. James 1:13-16

I am tempted of God:

for God cannot be tempted with evil, (*He is Impeccable. The Devil is the Tempter* Mt 4:1-11)

neither tempteth he any man:

Verse 14:

14 But every man is tempted, (1 Co 10:13, Ga 6:1)

when he is drawn away of his own lust, (Mt 5:28, Gen 3:6)

and enticed. (FM: Ex 22:16, Jg 14:15, Pr 1:10, 1 Co 2:4, Co 2:4)

Enticed:

Exodus 22:16 "And if a man entice a maid that is not betrothed, and lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife."

Judges 14:15 "And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they said unto Samson's wife, Entice thy husband, that he may declare unto us the riddle, lest we burn thee and thy father's house with fire: have ye called us to take that we have? is it not so?"

Proverbs 1:10 "My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not."

1 Corinthians 2:4 "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: Margin: Or, *persuasive*."

Colossians 2:4 "And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words."
