Governor:

Strong G2116 εὐθύνω euthýnō, yoo-thoo'-no from G2117; to straighten (level); technically, to steer:—governor, make straight. Adverb.

Listeth:

Matthew 17:12 "But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them."
