2 **James Lesson 16 Chapter 4:1-6**

1 From whence *come* wars and fightings among you? *come they* not hence, *even* of your lusts that war in your members? 2 Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. 3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume *it* upon your lusts. 4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. 5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? 6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. James 4:1-6

4 **James Lesson 16 Chapter 4:1-6**

2 Ye lust, and have not:
ye kill, and desire to have,
and cannot obtain:
ye fight and war, yet ye have not,
because ye ask not. (Matt 6:8, Jn 16:24)

5 **James Lesson 16 Chapter 4:1-6**

3 Ye ask, and receive not, (Is 59:1-2, 1 Jn 5:14)
because ye ask amiss, (Ro 8:26)
that ye may consume *it* upon your lusts. (1 Jn 2:15-16)

6 **James Lesson 16 Chapter 4:1-6**

4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, (FM: Lev 20:10, Ps 73:27, Matt 12:39-40)
know ye not that the friendship of the world (Mt 6:24)
is enmity with God? (Ro 8:7)
whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (Jn 15:19, 17:14)
Note: Israel should be like Abraham James 2:23, 2 Ch 20:7, Is 41:8

5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, (*Some scripture was spoken and not written, Num 21:14, Matt 27:9, Jn 7:38, Ac 20:35*)
The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? (Gen 6:5, 8:21, Ti 3:5)

6 But he giveth more grace. (Pr 3:34)
Wherefore he saith,
God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. (1 Pe 5:5)
