2  **James Lesson 20 Chapter 5:1-6**

1 Go to now, *ye rich men*, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon *you*. 2 Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten. 3 Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days. 4 Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth. 5 Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter. 6 Ye have condemned *and* killed the just; *and* he doth not resist you. James 5:1-6

1 Go to now, (4:13, FM: Ge 11:3-7)

*ye rich men*, (Lk 6:24-25)

weep and howl (Is 15:-3, Joel 1:5)

for your miseries that shall come upon *you*. (Ecc 8:6, Lam 1:7, Ro 3:16)

2 Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten.

Matthew 6:20 "But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:"

3 Your gold and silver is cankered; (2 Ti 2:17)

and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, (Job 16:8)

and shall eat your flesh as it were fire.

Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days. (Ro 2:5)

6  **James Lesson 20 Chapter 5:1-6**

4 Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, (Lk 10:7, Jer 22:13)

which is of you kept back (Ac 5:1-2, 20:20)

by fraud, (Le 19:13, De 24:14-15)

crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth. (Ro 9:29, Is 1:9)

7  **James Lesson 20 Chapter 5:1-6**

5 Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, (Job 21:13, Lk 16:19)

and been wanton; (2 Pe 2:18)

ye have nourished your hearts,

as in *a day of slaughter*. (Zech 11:4)

8  **James Lesson 20 Chapter 5:1-6**

6 Ye have condemned *and* killed the just; (2:6, 4:2, Ac 3:14, 7:52)

*and* he doth not resist you.
