3 The Number Six

- Six appears 204 times across 191 verses in the KJB. That does not include the various forms of six i.e., or ordinal numbers, 6th, 66th. Also, as a fraction it appears as the sixth part. As a %, it is 16.67% of the whole.
- Sixth appears 47 times across 44 verses in the KJB.
- The number Six is the number of Man in the KJB. It is also the manifestation of sin.
- The Top 6 books that have the most verses containing Six are: Exodus (25) 13.09%, Numbers (24) = 12.57%, 1 Chronicles (18) 9.42%, 2 Chronicles (14) 7.33%, Ezra (13) 6.81%, Ezekiel (11) 5.76%.

4 The Number Six

- The First Mention of Six is Genesis 7:6 "And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth."
- The First Mention of Sixth is Genesis 1:31 "And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

• The First Mention of Sixth is Genesis 1:31 And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, *it was* very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

What was created on the Sixth Day?

- Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.
- Genesis 6:6 And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

7 The Number Six & Work

- Exodus 20:9 Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:
- Exodus 23:12 Six days thou shalt do thy work, and on the seventh day thou shalt rest: that thine ox and thine ass may rest, and the son of thy handmaid, and the stranger, may be refreshed.
- Deuteronomy 16:8 Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread: and on the seventh day *shall be* a solemn assembly to the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work *therein*.
- Ezekiel 46:1 Thus saith the Lord GOD; The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the sabbath it shall be opened, and in the day of the new moon it shall be opened.
- Luke 13:14 And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.
- Exodus 21:2 If thou buy an Hebrew servant, six years he shall serve: and in the seventh he shall go out free for nothing.

8 The Number Six & Threescore

- Genesis 46:26 All the souls that came with Jacob into Egypt, which came out of his loins, besides Jacob's sons' wives, all the souls *were* threescore and six;
- Psalm 90:10 The days of our years *are* threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength *they* be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.
- 1 Timothy 5:9 Let not a widow be taken into the number under threescore years old, having been the wife of one man,

9 The Number Six & The Lord Jesus Christ

- Matthew 17:1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,
- John 2:6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.
- John 12:1 Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.
- John 19:14 And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews, Behold your King!

10 The Number Six & Romans

- Romans 2:1 Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.
- Romans 2:3 And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?
- Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with *him*, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

11 The Number Six & The Number of a Man

- Revelation 13:16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads:
- 17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.
- 18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six.
