

3 The Number Nine

- The cardinal number Nine appears 51 times across 50 verses in the KJB. That does not include the various forms of nine, i.e., ninety, or ordinal numbers, 9th, 19th. Also, as a fraction it appears as the ninth part. It is the greatest single-digit number.
- Nine in the Bible is the number of fruitfulness. The main reason for this is the ninefold fruit of the Spirit in the ninth book of the New Testament, Galatians 5:22 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law."
- The First Mention of nine is Genesis 5:5 "And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died."
- The Last Mention of nine: Luke 17:17 And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where *are* the nine?
- The Top three books that mention 9 are: Genesis = 11 (22%); Joshua = 6 (12%); 2 Kings = 5 (10%)

4 The Number Nine

- The FM of ninth is Leviticus 23:32 It *shall be* unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth *day* of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.
- The LM of ninth is Revelation 21:20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.
- The Top Three books that mention ninth are: Jeremiah = 6 (18.18%); 2 Kings = 4 (12.12%); 1 Chronicles = 4 (12.12%)

5 The Word Nine

In English: NINE, a. Denoting the number composed of eight and one; as nine men; nine days.

- NINE, n. The number composed of eight and one; or the number less by a unit than ten; three times three.

In Hebrew: תשע *têsha'*, *tay'-shah* or (masculine) תשעה *tish'âh*; perhaps from H8159 through the idea of a turn to the next or full number ten; nine or (ordinal) ninth:—nine (+ -teen, + -teenth, -th).

In Greek: ἐννέα *ennéa*, *en-neh'-ah* a primary number; nine:—nine.

In Latin: novem = nine. November is the ninth month in the old Roman calendar.

7 The Number Nine & Noah

- Genesis 9:1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.
- Genesis 9:7 And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein.
- Genesis 9:29 And all the days of Noah were nine hundred and fifty years: and he died.

8 The Number Nine and Abraham

- Genesis 17:1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I *am* the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.
- Genesis 17:5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.
- Genesis 17:6 And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee.
- Genesis 17:17 Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall *a child* be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

9 The Number Nine -Ephraim

- Genesis 41:52 And the name of the second called he Ephraim: For God hath caused me to be fruitful in the land of my affliction.
- עֲפְרַיִם Ephrayim, *ef-rah'-yim* dual of masculine form of H672; double fruit; Ephrajim, a son of Joseph; also the tribe descended from him, and its territory:—Ephraim, Ephraimites. *proper masculine noun*
- עֲפְרַת Ephrâth, *ef-rawth'* or עֲפְרַתָּה Ephrâthâh; from H6509; fruitfulness; Ephrath, another name for Bethlehem;—once (Ps 132:6) perhaps for Ephraim; also of an Israelitish woman; Ephrath, Ephratah.

10 The Number Nine -Carmel

- 2 Kings 19:23 By thy messengers thou hast reproached the Lord, and hast said, With the multitude of my chariots I am come up to the height of the mountains, to the sides of Lebanon, and will cut down the tall cedar trees thereof, *and* the choice fir trees thereof: and I will enter into the lodgings of his borders, *and into* the forest of his Carmel.
- Isaiah 33:9 The earth mourneth *and* languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed *and* hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off *their fruits*.

12 The Number Nine and Paul

The Gifts of the Spirit are ninefold:

- 1 Corinthians 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;
- 9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
- 10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another *divers* kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

- Fluorine 9th element. Atomic Weight = 18.998
- As a solid = Fluorite aka, Topaz
- Revelation 21:20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.
- The "Perfect Game" is Baseball
- "A Full term" is 9 months
- "A Fruitful year" $1+6+1+1 = 9$
- "A Fruitful Book" = King James
