Our little island of Palawan was hit with a record rainfall in this month of February. In four day's time, <u>a steady, heavy rain dumped on us the equivalent of a normal 6-month's rainfall</u>. Flooding followed. Some lives were lost, including a whole family whose van was swept off of a bridge. There was a good bit of damage to homes and infrastructure, and Federal funds were provided to help those affected.

Driving home in a heavy rain, we saw 8 young boys sitting in the edge of the street in a wide puddle. They were shirtless and smiling. Also they were beckoning with their hands, as if to say: "bring it on". I am happy to report that we baptized 8 boys by total immersion in less than 5 seconds!
