The year 2024 ended without much ado. It was a year full of blessings, battles, trials and tribulations. Thank God for His amazing grace. I'm not looking back. I'm reminded of the song, "Onward Christian Soldiers! Amen? Praise the Lord for his promise that our labour is not in vain in the Lord. (Galatians 6:9) We shall reap if we faint not!

The year 2025 started off with sadness and blessings. I performed two funerals in early January. The first was the sudden death of a young mother, 42 years old, named Johanne. Her death was very tragic. We never met Johanne but the church had been praying some time for her. Her mother is a member of the church and requested prayer for Johanne many times. Johanne had a drug problem for several years and lived a very sad life. Her last week was spent at her mother's. Johanne's liver and kidneys finally gave out. Her end was not nice. The NHS, National Health Service, wasn't able to get an ambulance to her for several hours. When she finally got to the hospital emergency room the doctors told her, "you are going to die." Johanne's mother had witnessed to her for years to no avail. However in Johanne's dying moments her mom, holding her hand, witnessed to her one last time. She told Johanne about Christ's forgiveness and salvation and that if she would put her faith and trust in Jesus Christ he would save her. If you'll ask God's forgiveness and accept Jesus

Christ as your saviour will you squeeze my hand at which Johanne did and passed away. Was she truly saved you might ask? Only God knows but Johanne's mother has a glimmer of hope. (Romans 10:13)

As you know, the ministry is about ministering to people. We have for many, many years gone into our local care home to sing and witness to staff and residents. One lady in the home, Lesley, was a lady who thanked us every time we attended. She sang many of the songs we sang. We ended every service with the song, "Jesus Loves Me" which Lesley sang so boldly. One morning I received a phone call from the care home telling me that a family wanted me to call them. It was sad to hear that Lesley, 87 years old, had suddenly, but peacefully, passed away. The family asked if I would perform her memorial service as Lesley loved our visiting and singing. There was a testimony of faithfully attending church but not a clear cut testimony of salvation. However, I as well as others, could feel something different about Lesley. Sadly I can't say for certain that Lesley was in heaven, but the spirit of the service was unlike any I had ever experienced for a person with no sure testimony of salvation. I did get to witness to everyone about the truth of salvation and I did give every family member of both funerals a God's Simple Plan of Salvation as well as a tract called Amazing Grace.

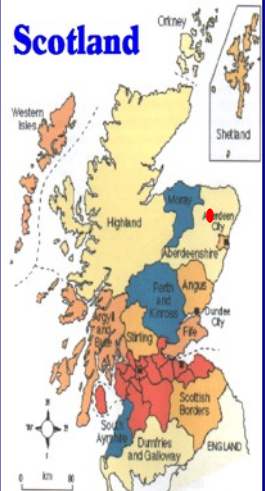
