4 Queen Elizabeth 1 (1558-1603)

- Daughter of Henry VIII & Ann Boleyn b.1533
- Her caretaker was Matthew Parker
- Imprisoned by her sister Mary in the Tower of London 1554
- Became Queen upon the death of Mary
- The longest living Tudor monarch
- "The Elizabethan Age"

5 Archbishop Matthew Parker (1559-1575)

- Born 1504
- Cambridge Scholar
- · Licenced to preach by Cranmer
- Became Ann Boleyn's chaplain
- 1544 elected Master at Corpus Christ College
- Demoted under Mary 1
- Appointed Archbishop of Canterbury by Elizabeth in 1559

8 Guidelines for the Translators

The translators were to observe the following:

1. Follow the Great Bible and not to recede from it but where it varies manifestly from the Greek or Hebrew original

- 2. To make use of the versions of Pagninus and Münster.
- 3. To abstain from bitter and or controversial note.
- 4. To mark sections not edifying for public reading.

5. And to substitute more convenient terms and phrases for all such words as sound [tend] in the old translation to any offence of lightness or obscenity.

10 Robert Estienne's Greek Text - 1551

- First used with the Geneva Bible in 1557
- The Bishops' Bible included the verse divisions generated by Estienne
