### 4 1 Peter Lesson 2 1:2-5

2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you,

Verse 2:

- Elect (1Pe 2:9) according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, (Acts 2:23, Rom 8:29)
- through sanctification of the Spirit, (2 Th 2:13)
- unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: (Heb 10:22)
- Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. (Rom 1:7, Is 60:17)



### Verse 3:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, (2 Co 1:3, Eph 1:3) which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again (1 Pe 1:23) unto a lively hope (Rom 6:23, 2 Th 2:16) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (1 Pe 3:21)

Verse 5:

Compare with Paul:

- Galatians 3:23 But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed.
- 1 Corinthians 1:24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.
- 2 Corinthians 13:4 For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you.
