2 ☐ **1 Peter Lesson 13 Chapter 3:1-7**

1 Likewise, ye wives, *be* in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; 2 While they behold your chaste conversation *coupled* with fear. 3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward *adorning* of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; 4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price. 5 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: 6 Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement. 7 Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with *them* according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered. 1 Peter 3:1-7

Verse 1:

Likewise, [see chapter 2:18 Servants]

ye wives, (v.5 also)

be in subjection to your own husbands; (1 Co 7:2, Eph 5:22, Col 3:18)

that, if any obey not the word,

they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; (3:16, 1 Co 7:16, Php 1:27)

Verse 2:

While they behold your chaste conversation *coupled* with fear. (Ti 2:5)

- Titus 2:5 *To be* discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Verse 3:

Whose adorning let it not be that outward *adorning* of plaiting the hair, (1 Ti 2:9-10)

and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; (Zech 14:14)

- Zechariah 14:14 And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

Verse 4:

But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, (Ps 45:13, Ro 7:22)

in that which is not corruptible,

- Psalm 45:13 The king's daughter *is* all glorious within: her clothing *is* of wrought gold.

- Romans 7:22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, (Eph 4:2, 1 Ti 2:2)

which is in the sight of God of great price. (Matt 13:46)

Verse 5:

For after this manner in the old time the holy women also,
who trusted in God,
adorned themselves,
being in subjection unto their own husbands: *[second time]*

- Titus 2:3 The aged women likewise, that *they be* in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

Verse 6:

Even as Sara obeyed Abraham,
calling him lord: (Gen 18:12)

- Genesis 18:12 Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?
whose ⁺daughters ye are, (Gen 28:8-9)
as long as ye do well, *[conditional statement]*
and are not afraid with any amazement.

7 Likewise, ye husbands, (Col 3:19, Eph 5:25)
dwell with *them* according to knowledge,

- Colossians 3:19 Husbands, love *your* wives, and be not bitter against them.
- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;
giving honour unto the wife, (Pro 11:16, Ro 13:7)
as unto the weaker vessel, *[only usage in the KJB]*
and as being heirs together of the grace of life;
that your prayers be not hindered.
