8 Finally, *be ye* all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, *be* pitiful, *be* courteous: 9 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing. 10 For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: 11 Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. 12 For the eyes of the Lord *are* over the righteous, and his ears *are open* unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord *is* against them that do evil. 1 Peter 3:8-12

||love as brethren, Margin: Or, *loving to the brethren*. (1:22)
be pitiful, (= full of pity, Job 6:14, Jas 5:11)
be courteous:

Not rendering evil for evil, (Ro 12:17)
or railing for railing: (1 Co 5:11)
but contrariwise blessing; (Matt 5:44, Ro 12:14, Ro 12:20)

For he that will love life, and see good days, (Ps 34:12)
• Psalm 34:12 What man *is he that* desireth life, *and* loveth *many* days, that he may see good?

• Psalm 34:13 Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile.

Verse 12:

For the eyes of the Lord *are over* the righteous,

 but the face of the Lord *is* [†]against them that do evil. (Ps 34:15-16)

- Psalm 34:15 The eyes of the LORD *are upon* the righteous, and his ears *are open* unto their cry. 16 The face of the LORD *is* against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.

2 Romans 12:14-20

14 Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.
 15 Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.
 16 *Be* of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.
 17 Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.
 18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.
 19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but *rather* give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance *is* mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
 20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.
