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2 ☐ **1 Peter Lesson 18 Chapter 4:7-11**

7 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. 8 And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. 9 Use hospitality one to another without grudging. 10 As every man hath received the gift, *even so* minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. 11 If any man speak, *let him speak* as the oracles of God; if any man minister, *let him do it* as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. 1 Peter 4:7-11

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Verse 7:

But the end of all things is at hand: (Matt 24:14, Ro 13:12)

be ye therefore sober, (1:13) and watch unto prayer. (Mk 13:33, Lk 21:36)

- Mark 13:33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.
- Luke 21:36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

Contrast with this present time:

- Romans 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.
- Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- Colossians 4:3 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:

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Verse 8:

And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: (Pro 10:12)

for charity shall^{lll} cover the multitude of sins. (Col 3:14)

- Colossians 3:14 And above all these things *put on* charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
- 1 Timothy 1:5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and *of* a good conscience, and *of* faith unfeigned:

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Verses 9-10:

9 Use hospitality one to another without grudging.

(Ro 12:13, 1 Ti 3:2, Ti 3:8)

10 As every man hath received the gift, (Ro 12:6, 1 Co 12:4)

even so minister the same one to another,

as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. (Lk 12:42, 1 Co 4:1)

- Luke 12:42 And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom *his* lord shall make

ruler over his household, to give *them their* portion of meat in due season?

Contrast with this present time:

- 1 Corinthians 4:1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.

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Verse 11:

If any man speak, *let him speak* as the oracles of God; (Ro 3:2)

if any man minister, *let him do it* as of the ability which God giveth: (Ro 12:7)

that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ,
to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. (5:11)

- 1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.
