1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 2 Peter 1:1-3

Verse 1

Simon Peter, *[spelled Simeon in Acts 15:14]*

a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, (Ja 1:1; 1 Pe 1:1)

to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: (Ti 2:13)

Spot the difference:

- Romans 1:12 That is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me.
- Galatians 2:7 But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as *the gospel* of the circumcision was unto Peter;

Verse 2

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you (1 Pe 1:2)

through the knowledge of God, (vs. 3 & 8)

and of Jesus our Lord,

What did Paul Say?

- Ephesians 3:4 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ)

Verse 3

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, (vs. 6 & 7; 3:11)

through the knowledge of him that hath called us (1 Pe 2:9; 1 Th 2:12)

to glory (3x) and virtue (3x): [Margin: *by*. virtue and glory. Tyndale]

How did Paul word these things?

- 1 Timothy 6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;
- 1 Thessalonians 2:12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

8 2 Peter Lesson 1

To Glory

Isaiah 61:6 But ye shall be named the Priests of the LORD: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.

Isaiah 60:5 Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged; because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

1 Peter 1:7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:
