Verses 10 & 11:

10 Wherefore the rather, brethren,

give diligence to make your calling and election sure: (1:5)

for if ye do these things, (Jas 1:22) ye shall never fall:

11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Contrast with Paul:

- Colossians 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Verse 12

Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, (3x)

though ye know *them*, (3:17)

and be established in the present truth. (*Only mention here*)

By the numbers:

Truth = 247x; Truth's = 2x; Truths (pl.) = 1x in the margin Is. 26:2 Heb. *truths*.

Verse 13

Yea, I think it meet, (Lk 3:8)

as long as I am in this tabernacle, (2 Co 5:1-4)
to stir you up by putting *you* in remembrance;

Knowing that shortly I must put off *this* my tabernacle,

Contrast with Paul:

Acts 9:15 But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my
name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel: 16 For I will shew him how great
things he must suffer for my name's sake.

2 Corinthians 4:10 Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also
of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.

2 Corinthians 11:23 Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in labours more
abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

Verse 16

For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, (1 Ti 1:4)
when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were
eyewitnesses of his majesty. (Mt 17:1-2, Lk 1:2)

- Matthew 17:1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth
them up into an high mountain apart, 2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine
as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.
- Luke 1:2 Even as they delivered them unto us, which from the beginning were eyewitnesses, and
ministers of the word;
