Enemies

Romans 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. 10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. 11 And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement.

- Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.
- Ephesians 2:19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

- Tyndale NT (1526,34) No verse divisions one continuous sentence
- The first verse divisions were added in the Geneva, 1557 NT
- The sentence remains intact in our KJB.

Verse 22

In the body of his flesh through death,
to present you holy (1 Th 2:10)
and unblameable (Eph 1:4, 5:27)
and unreprouable [*not deserving reproof*]

in his sight:

Verse 23

If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, (Eph 3:17)
and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, (v.5)
which ye have heard,
and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven;
whereof I Paul am made a minister; (Eph 3:7; Ro 15:16)

Verse 24

Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, (2 Co 11:23-31)
and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake,
which is the church: (vs 18)

my sufferings for you,
2 Corinthians 11:23 Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.
24 Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one.
25 Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep;
26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;
27 In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.
28 Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily, the care of all the churches.
29 Who is weak, and I am not weak? who is offended, and I burn not?
30 If I must needs glory, I will glory of the things which concern mine infirmities.
31 The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which is blessed for evermore, knoweth that I lie not.
