25 Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God; 26 Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: 27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: 28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: 29 Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily. according to the dispensation of God [*next three slides*]
which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;

Verse 26

Even the mystery [3x in Colossians, 10x by Paul regarding the church] which hath been hid from ages and from generations,

but now is made manifest to his saints: (22x)

- Romans 16:25 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began, 26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:

Verse 27

To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery (2x. Ro 11:25)
among the Gentiles;

which is Christ in you,
the hope of glory:

Verse 28

Whom we preach, (Ro 10:8; 1 Co 1:23; 1 Th 2:9)

warning every man, (1 Co 4:14; 1 Th 5:14)

and teaching every man in all wisdom; (3:16; Job 32:7)

that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: (4:12; Eph 4:13)

Men in Colossians:

1. Every man: 1:28 (3x) Colossians 4:6 Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.
2. Any man: Colossians 2:4 And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words. Colossians 2:8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 3:13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.
3. No man: Colossians 2:16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Colossians 2:18 Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,
4. Old man: Colossians 3:9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;
5. New man: Colossians 3:10 And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:
6. The Man: 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

Verse 29

Whereunto I also labour,
striving according to his working,
which worketh in me mightily. 1 Co 15:10-11

- 1 Corinthians 15:10 But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.
- 1 Corinthians 15:11 Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.
