2 ☐ **Colossians Lesson Nine 2:13-17**

13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; 14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; 15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it. 16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: 17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ. Colossians 2:13-17

Verse 13

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, (Eph 2:1;Ro 6:2) hath he quickened together with him, (1 Co 15:22; Le 13:10; Eph 2:5) having forgiven you all trespasses; (Ps 103:2-3)

5 ☐ **Colossians Lesson Nine 2:13-17**

Verse 14

Blotting out [*contrast with Peter's message to Israel, Ac 3:19*]
the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, (2:20; FM: Ex 12:14)
which was contrary to us, [*some ordinances are not against us. 1 Co 11:2*]
and took it out of the way,
nailing it to his cross; (Eph 2:15-16)

9 ☐ **Colossians Lesson Nine 2:13-17**

Verse 15

And having spoiled principalities and powers, (2:10; Eph 1:21)
he made a shew of them openly, (Ga 6:12)
triumphing over them in it.

- Galatians 6:12. As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.

Verse 16

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, (1 Ti 4:3)
or in drink, (1 Co 10:31)
or in ||respect of an holyday, [*holi day*]
or of the new moon, (Ho 2:12)
or of the sabbath days: (Ga 2:9-11)

- 1 Tim.4: 3. Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

11 ☐ **Colossians Lesson Nine 2:13-17**

Meat - Romans 14:1 Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations. 2 For one believeth that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eateth herbs. 3 Let not him that eateth despise him that eateth not; and let not him which eateth not judge him that eateth: for God hath received him.

Days – Romans 14:5 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind. 6 He that regardeth the day, regardeth it unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard it. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

Judge this rather

- Romans 14:13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.
- 15 But if thy brother be grieved with thy meat, now walkest thou not charitably. Destroy not him with thy meat, for whom Christ died.
- 21 It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.

Days

- Galatians 2: 9. But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?
10. Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years.
11. I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

Verse 17

Which are a shadow of things to come; [*not were NASV*]
but the body is of Christ.
